watercolour

I live in Cumbria, in the corner of a field. From here I can see; wild flowers of azelea, campion, garlic and strawberry and through the changing seasons I'm learning to recognise the flowers as they appear and grow, then blossom and flower, and gently fade and fall to feed the ground through winter

Watercolour painting workshop:

One day hands-on workshop to explore some techniques that I use when painting flowers with watercolour. Time in the gardens with the flowers in a peaceful and calming setting. Painting in the Loft with vases of cut flowers from the gardens.

I paint portraits. I invite people to sit for me. I paint people from life, mostly they are painted in one day. I start with a charcoal study, then I work in oil on un-sized fine linen.

Drawing with charcoal is a joy, I can get my hands mucky, achieve really dark areas, put light back in with putty, it has a sculptural feel Life drawing workshop:
